

MARK-MAKING

Ideas for creating texture and making collage papers

1. White / Black / Gray Crayons
Press hard / Create grids, squiggles, patterns
2. Use black ink on tissue paper to make loose "calligraphy". Cut up when it's dry.
3. Drop bleach onto fluid watercolors
4. Use a comb  → pull it through wet paint
5. Use toothbrush splatter through a grid.
6. Use Fineline masking pen first. Let it dry. Paint juicy, intense analogous colors over the masking fluid.
7. Use 50% glue solution to glue assorted papers onto your watercolor paper.

GLUE MIX:

- $\frac{1}{2}$ water
- $\frac{1}{2}$ Elmer's white glue (not school glue)
